

Proposed Amendment to the Diocesan Constitution & Canons (first reading)

Article VI, Section 16

In addition to the lay members described above in this section, ~~one youth or young adult person, aged 14 to 22, from each Deanery chosen by the Program Group on Youth and Young Adult Ministries, with the consent of the Pastoral/Liturgical Authority of their ecclesial community,~~ ten youth, aged 16, 17, or 18 (and still enrolled in high school at the time of Diocesan Convention), identified in a process approved by Diocesan Council, shall be entitled to seat, voice, and vote at each meeting of Convention.

As amended would read:
